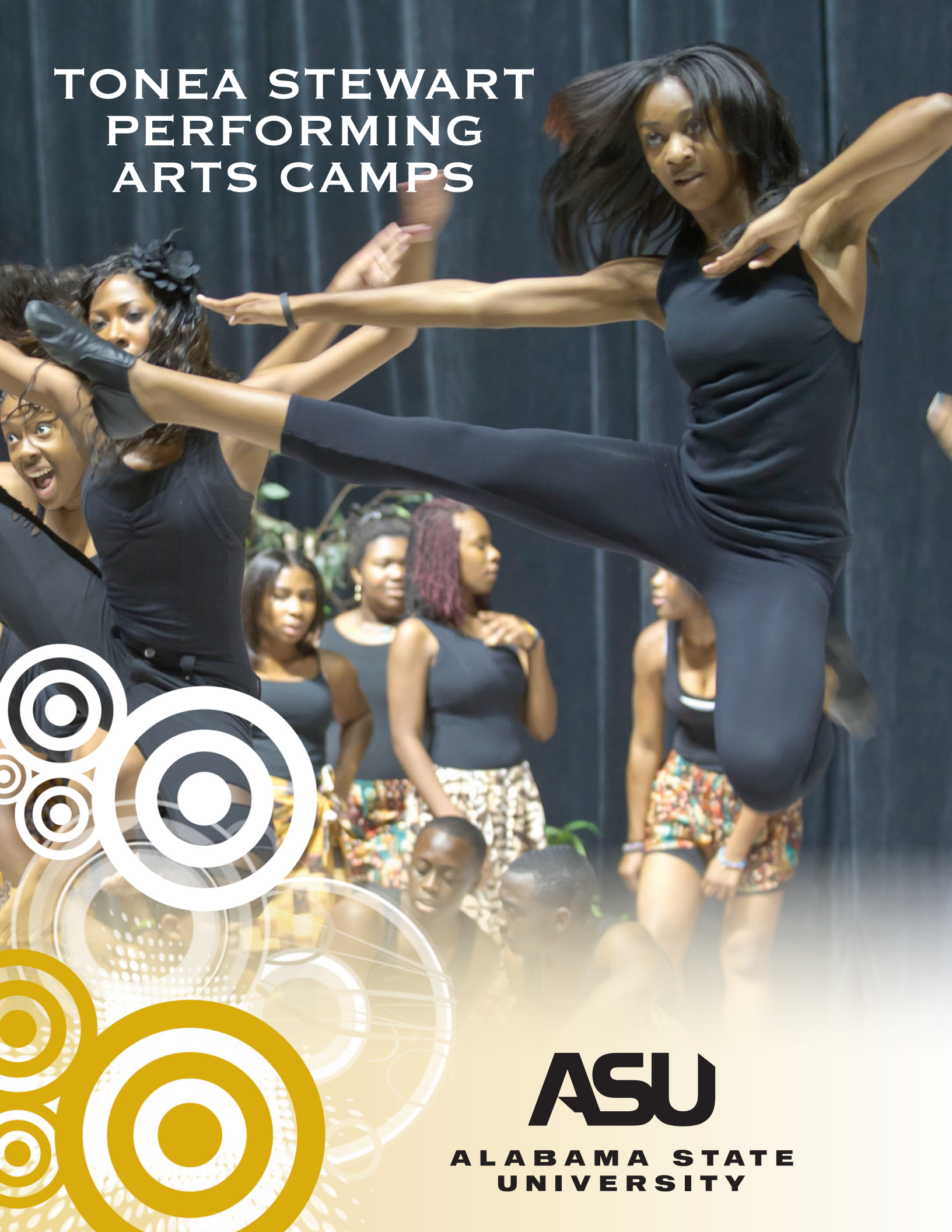

TTI, or Technical Theatre Initiative, uses the practical side of theatre to focus on technical career training and trade skills that qualify one for the world of work. GIFTED or Giving Individuals Freedom to Express Diversity, is a program specifically designed as an outlet for persons with disabilities. These programs offer classes in acting, singing, dancing, technical theatre, reading, modeling, creative writing, professionalism, public speaking, and oral interpretation.

Dear Camp Supporters,


